- 13 Section 1. The act of January 10, 1968 (1967 P.L.925,
- 14 No.417), referred to as the Legislative Officers and Employes
- 15 Law, is amended by adding a section to read:
- 16 Section 57. (a) In addition to any other duty imposed under
- any statute, rule, policy or quideline, the Chief Clerk of the 17
- Senate, the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the 18
- 19 comptroller of the House of Representatives shall publish
- quarterly a list of the following expenses of the Senate and 20
- House of Representatives on a publicly accessible Internet 21

- 2 (1) Per diems for each member of the Senate and House of
- 3 Representatives.
- 4 (2) Travel allowances and reimbursements.
- 5 (3) Meals and lodging.
- 6 (4) Equipment and furnishing control and inventory.
- 7 <u>(5) District office expenses.</u>
- 8 (6) Capitol office expenses.
- 9 <u>(7) Official expenses.</u>
- 10 (8) Special expenses.
- 11 (9) Miscellaneous expenses of standing and special
- 12 <u>committees.</u>
- 13 (b) The following information shall be included on the list
- 14 of expenses required under subsection (a):
- 15 <u>(1) The member or individual for whom the expense was</u>
- 16 <u>submitted</u>, <u>paid</u> and <u>reimbursed</u>.
- 17 (2) The date the expense was incurred, submitted, paid and
- 18 <u>reimbursed</u>.
- 19 (3) The legislative purpose for the expense.
- 20 (4) The account from which the expense was paid or
- 21 <u>reimbursed</u>.
- 22 (c) The list of expenses required under subsection (a) shall
- 23 be in a format that is searchable by name, office, account, date
- 24 and any other format authorized by:
- 25 (1) For the Senate, the Senate Committee on Management
- 26 Operations.
- 27 (2) For the House of Representatives, the House Committee on
- 28 Management Operations or the House Bipartisan Management
- 29 Committee.
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
